Shabbat Parashat Vayehi

In this morning's Torah portion, *Vayehi*, we find Jacob offering his final words to his sons. His words are a combination of prayer, blessing, curse, psychological assessment and hope. Jacob's words are spoken in poetic form on his death bed. The Talmud equates words of a dying man to be as binding as a deed which is written and delivered. Traditional commentators have understood Jacob's final words as prophetic. As we say farewell to this wondrous book, Genesis/*Bereshit*, may we be blessed with the privilege to re-visit it again next year, gleaning yet more insight into God and life.
