Beyond that, the story of Korah's failed rebellion can provide a lesson of a different sort. Next time you complain and challenge authority, ask yourself what the motive behind doing so is? Ask yourself if you are motivated by a desire to build or to topple, to serve God, or to serve yourself? Most importantly, ask if your own style of leadership is more akin to Korah, or to Moses?
